**Objectives:** After attending the seminar, participants should be able to:

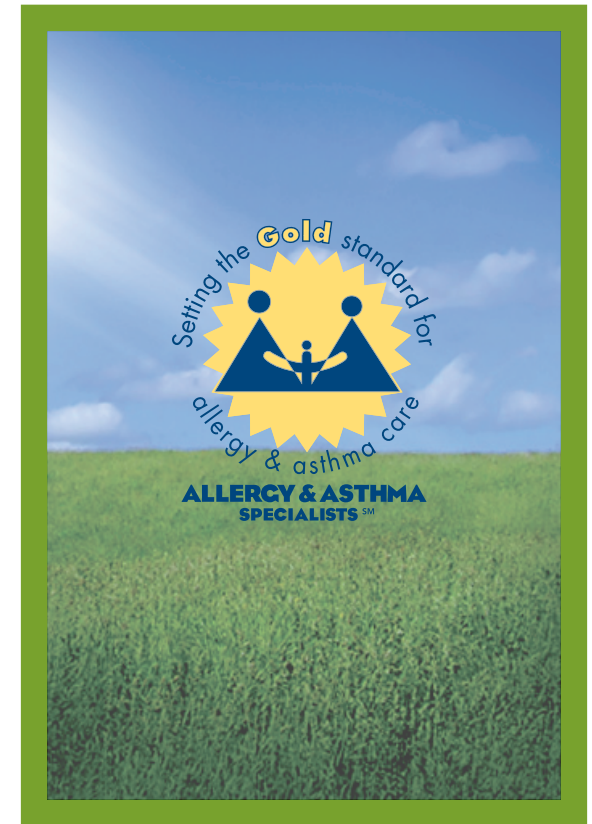
